



Echo Point is on the way to Top Station. **Nyayamakad** - is a land of breathtaking waterfalls. Return to resort/hotel, dinner and overnight

Day 10: Munnar:

Ensconced within is the picture perfect Pearl Mosque, which is a major tourist attraction. Overnight. (Taj Mahal remains closed on every Friday)

Day 04: Agra / Gwalior:

Morning breakfast, checkout and drive to Gwalior. On arrival check into Hotel. Later proceed for sightseeing visit Jai Vilas Palace – this Palace is famous for its ornate Chandeliers & crystal. A few of the rooms have been converted into a museum filled with the Scindia dynasty memorabilia. Visit the huge



Gwalior Fort – where a sun temple is believed to have been constructed within the area of the fort, Visit **Man Mandir**, which is a six-towered palace and forms the eastern wall of the fort. The fort has monuments dating back to 8th Century AD onwards and is one of the largest forts in India. Back tp Hotel. Overnight.

Day 05: Gwalior / Khajuraho:

Morning breakfast, checkout and drive to Khajuraho. On arrival check into Hotel. Relax and overnight.

Day 06: Khajuraho:

See the great stupa No.1 the oldest stone structure in India, 36.5 mts in diameter and 16.4 mts high and with a massive hemispherical dome, the dome stands in eternal majesty. It has paved procession path around it worn smooth by centuries of visiting pilgrims. Four gateways - Eastern, Western, Southern, Northern gateway; Stupa No.2, No.3 and the Ashoka Pillar. The Buddhist Vihara, The great bowl - carved out of one block of stone. this mammoth bowl was carved to contain food that was distributed amongst the monks of Sanchi. The Gupta temple, the museum also are worth visiting. Udaigiri Caves -

Hewn from local sandstone in the Gupta period there are 20 caves. The finest cave is no. 5 with a colossal representation of Vishnu delivering the earth goddess Prithvi from the water demon, watched by angels and demons. Overnight at hotel.

Day 10: Bhopal / Ujjain / Indore:

Morning after breakfast checkout and drive to Indore enroute visit **Ujjain** - One of the seven holy cities of the Hindus, situated on the banks of Khipra, is a much frequented pilgrimage centre. The famous Kumbha Mela is celebrated with great splendor every twelve years. On arrival at Indore check into Hotel. Relax or proceed for sightseeing and overnight.

Day 11: Indore / Mandu:

Morning after breakfast checkout and drive to Mandu enroute visit Omkareshwar - A holy island, shaped like the sacred Hindu symbol 'OM', Omkareshwar continues to draw thousands of devotees. Here the rivers Narmada and Kaveri meet and pilgrims gather at the confluence in large numbers to kneel and pay obeisance before the Jyotirlinga (one of the twelve throughout India) at the temple of Sri Omkar Mandhata. On arrival at Mandu check into Hotel. Mandu is one of the most interesting sites of Central India. Perched along the Vindhya ranges at an altitude of 2,000 fee, Mandu with its natural defenses was originally the fort capital of the Parmar rulers of Malwa. Towards the end of the 13th Century it came under the sway of the Sultans of Malwa, the first of whom named it Shadiabad - "city of joy". And indeed the pervading spirit of Mandu was of gaiety, and its rulers built exquisite palaces, ornamental canals, baths and pavilions, as graceful and refined as those times of peace and plenty. Back to hotel. Overnight.

Day 12: Mandu / Aurangabad:

Morning after breakfast checkout and drive to Aurangabad. On arrival check into Hotel. Overnight.

Day 13: Aurangabad / Ajanta Caves / Aurangabad:

Full day visit of Ajanta Caves - the Ajanta caves were discovered by the British maneuvering troops in 1819. This consists of 24 monasteries and 5 temples some of which are over 2000

years old. The story of Lord Buddha is depicted in the frescoes which are remarkable. (Ajanta Caves is Closed on Monday) Overnight at hotel.


Day 14: Aurangabad / Ellora Caves / Mumbai:

Drive to Srirangapatna - Island fortress of Tipu Sultan - Visit Tipu's summer Palace, Mosque, and Ranganatha Swamy Temple. Lunch and visit nearby Ranganathittu Bird Sanctuary and later proceed to Brindavan Gardens after sundown, when musical fountains and colored lights transform this place into a magical fairyland. Return to hotel and overnight.

Day 05: Mysore / Nagarahole National Park - Kabini

Morning breakfast, check out and proceed to visit Chamundi hill and drive to - **Kabini** - Nestled in the southern fringes of the Nagarahole National Park, it is a perfect getaway for nature lovers. The breathtaking locale with the tranquil backwaters of the River Kabini presents an ideal setting for a longawaited vacation. Check in on arrival

and proceed for buffet lunch. Wildlife safari in the evening. Wildlife Film followed by camp fire and buffet dinner. Overnight.

Day 06: Nagarahole National Park / Hassan

Day 07: Hassan – Belur – Halebeedu – Hassan Day Tour

Breakfast and proceed for a day tour to **Belur** and **Halebid**, the most photographed and perhaps the best examples of Hoysala Temple architecture they are a must on every tourist's temple itinerary. The temples, perched on a star-shaped base amidst lawns, are a sculptural extravaganza. Return to hotel for lunch. Rest of the day at leisure. Overnight.

Day 08: Hassan / Hospet – Hampi:

Early breakfast, checkout and proceed to **Hampi**- A world heritage center, the ruins of Hampi, the capital of the Vijayanagar Kingdom evoke memories of the grandeur of a bygone era. Lunch enroute. On arrival at Hospet check into a hotel. Return to Hotel and Overnight.

Day 09: Hospet - Hampi:

Morning breakfast, and proceed for full day sightseeing, visit King's Palace - this is the largest enclosure, including two major platform structures, an underground chamber which must have served as a treasury or private audience hall. Mahanavami Dibba - Equally impressive is the massive Mahanavami Dibba, where the kings once sat on gem-studded golden throne and watched processions pass by. Queen's Bath - this Structure has a very plain exterior but the interior is stunningly ornate, with graceful arched corridors, projecting balconies and lotus-shaped fountains that used to spout perfumed Water for the ladies of the court. Return to hotel and overnight.

Day 10: Hospet / Badami:

Morning breakfast, check out and proceed to Badami, enroute visit Pattadakal - A World Heritage Site it has 10 major temples representing early Chalukyan architecture. Lunch and there on drive to Aihole - famous as the Cradle of Indian Temple Architecture, it has over 125 temples all intricately carved and rich in detail. Famous ones are Lad Khan Temple, Durga Temple, Ravalphadi Cave Temple, Konti Temple Complex, Jain Meguti Temple are a few not to be missed. On arrival at Badami, check in to a Hotel and rest of the day free. Overnight.

Day 11: Badami / Goa

Morning breakfast, checkout and proceed to visit **Badami Caves** –

picturesquely situated at the mouth of a ravine between two rocky hills, the exquisite sculptures and the rust red sandstone cliffs of Badami tell many a tale of vore. North Fort - A climb takes you to the Temples, the remains of a granary, a treasury and a watchtower on top of the fort. Banashankari - is a quaint hamlet taking its name from the temple to goddess Banashankari. Thereon proceed

to Goa, enroute lunch at Belgaum. **Goa**-Variously known as "Pearl of the Orient" and a "Tourist Paradise", has magnificent scenic beauty and the architectural splendors of its temples, churches and old houses have made Goa a firm favorite with travellers around the world. On arrival check in to a Beach Resort. Eevening free and overnight.

Day 12: Goa:

Morning breakfast and proceed for half day tour, visit **Cabo da Rama** - named after Rama, the hero of the Hindu epic Ramayana, who, along with his wife Sita stayed here during his exile from Ayodhya. There on visit famous

Crocodile Bank - not far from Mamallapuram, Romulus Whittaker runs this crocodile breeding and research center. Morning breakfast and proceed for full day sightseeing, cover **Cubbon Park, Bull Temple** - Dravidian-style temple, has a huge monolithic Bull is the vahana of Lord Shiva, Government Museum - Acclaimed as one of the oldest museums in the country, **Tippu's palace** - Tippu Sultan's summer retreat is a two-storied ornate wooden structure, **Indira Gandhi Musical Fountain**-View the colourful swirling fountains dancing in tune to music. Evening Free for shopping. Overnight.

Day 06: Bangalore/Hassan

Morning breakfast, checkout and proceed to Hassan, enroute visit **Shravanabelagola** - a jain saint. Standing atop one of the hills and is said to be one of the tallest and most graceful monolithic statues in the

world. On arrival at Hassan check into a hotel. Afternoon visit **Belur** - it is the only Hoysala temple still in active worship. The most marvelous specimens of Hoysala architecture. **Halebid** - just 17 kms away from Belur, the ancient capital of the Hoysalas. The temple complex has a museum which houses the idols, statues, busts and sculptures excavated by the Archaeological Department from the ruins. Return to hotel and overnight.

Day 07: Hassan/Mysore

After breakfast, check out and proceed to Mysore. On arrival, check into a hotel. Lunch & visit Srirangapatna-Island fortress of Tippu Sultan, Tippu's summer Palace, Mosque and Sriranganatha Temple and evening visit Brindavan Garden- the Krishna Raja Sagar Dam after sundown, when musical fountains and colored lights transform this place into a magical fairyland. Return to hotel and overnight.

Day 08: Mysore

Morning breakfast visit to **Maharaja Palace**- the palace is a splendid structure in the Indo-saracenic style, among its many attractions are a magnificent gold throne. It is an entirely modern structure continuing the Hindu and Saracenic styles of Architecture,

Chamundi Hills-perched a top a hill is the temple of Chamundeshwari, a tall Mahishasura statue are added attractions. Return to hotel and overnight.

Day 09: Mysore/Bandipur National Park

Morning breakfast, check out and proceed to Bandipur National Park-Nestling in the foothills of the Nilgiris. It is one of the Tiger reserves in the country. It also forms part of Nilgiri Biosphere Reserve, which is one of the last refuges of endangered Asiatic wild elephants. On arrival, check into a resort. Evening jeep safari into the jungle, return to resort and overnight.

Day 10: Bandipur National Park / Ooty

Early morning after a cup of coffee/tea, be lead by a trained naturalist into the Tiger Reserve on a nature walk. Get back to resort in time for freshening and breakfast. This is one of the highest falls in the Nilgiris. Return to hotel, evening free and overnight.

Day 12: Ooty / Cochin

Morning breakfast, checkout and proceed to **Cochin**- commercial capital and the most cosmopolitan city of Kerala, Kochi, is also known as the

Queen of the Arabian Sea. On arrival check into hotel. Evening free and overnight.

Day 13: Cochin

Morning breakfast and full day city tour to Cochin St. Francis Church these centuries old church at Fort Kochi was originally built completely of timber and later reconstructed in stone masonry, Pierce Leslie **Bungalow** - this charming mansion was

the office of Pierce Leslie characteristic features are wood panels that form the roof of the ground floor, arched doorways, carved doors and sprawling rooms. Waterfront verandas are an added attraction. Loafer's Corner/Princess Street - One of the earliest streets to be constructed in Fort Kochi, traditional meeting place and hangout of the jovial fun loving people of the area. Return to hotel and overnight

Day 14: Cochin

Morning breakfast and full day city sightseeing, visit to Maritime Museum throws light on the genesis, history, evolution and landmarks of the Indian Navy, Indo-Portuguese Museum - the museum today is an important center to understand the Indo-Portuguese Christian Art heritage, Fort Kochi turning it into one of the finest natural harbors in the world. Vasco da Gama Square – an ideal place to watch fishermen use these nets is the Vasco da Gama square, a narrow promenade along the beach, Willingdon Island – it's a man-made island, surrounded by beautiful backwaters. The island is the city's best hotels and trading centres, the Port Trust and the headquarters of



the southern naval command. **Bolghatty Island** - This lush, lovely island is famous for its palace. Evening return to hotel, and overnight

Day 15: Cochin

Morning breakfast, check out and transfer to Airport to board the flight for onward journey. **Tour Ends**.

Day 05: Ooty

Morning breakfast, proceed for full day sight seeing visit to **Botanical Garden** is spread over 22 hectares ascending the slopes on the hill, **Rose Garden**-the rose varieties planted in this part were assembled from different sources. Initially 17,256 rose plants from 1919 varieties have been planted, Deer park-It is one of the high altitude animal part

in India, **Doddabetta**- It is highest peak in the Nilgiris and the name Doddabetta literally means 'big mountain' which is so in reality, **Ooty Lake**- The Ooty Lake is the pride of the Blue Hills. It is central and strategic attraction, which is good for boating. Return to hotel and overnight.

Day 06: Ooty/Kodaikanal

Morning breakfast, checkout and proceed to **Kodaikana**l - the charm of Kodaikanal Hill station lies in its wooded slopes and gigantic trees. The mighty rocks, bowers, creeks and slopes captivate the visitors, check in on arrival to hotel. Rest of the day free to relax and overnight.

Day 07: Kodaikanal

Morning breakfast, full-day sight seeing visit to **Coakers walk**-runs along a steep slope on the southern side of Kodai. It offers some of the best views of the plains, Green Valley View-commands a beautiful view of the entire Vaigai Dam, this place was once known as 'Suicide point'. The Lake-is the focal point in Kodai, boating can be done here, Pillar Rocks-Three boulders stand shoulderto-shoulder, providing a majestic sight. It has a garden with lovely flowers, silent Valley View-just a little away from the pillar Rock, provides a breathtaking view, Berijam Lake View-provides a panoramic landscape view of Berijam Lake, Silver cascade falls - the overflow of Kodai Lake comes down here as 180

foot high waterfalls. Return to hotel and overnight.

Day 08: Kodaikanal

Morning breakfast and full day free to explore on your own. Overnight.

Day 09: Kodaikanal / Madurai

Morning breakfast, checkout and proceed to Madurai-known as the Athens of the East. On arrival, check into a hotel. Lunch and later on visit the famous **Sri Meenakshi Temple**-has long been the focus of both Indian and international tourist attraction as well as one of the most important places of Hindu Pilgrimage. Return to hotel, and overnight.

Day 10: Madurai / Rameshwaram / Madurai

Morning breakfast, day excursion to Rameshwaram - small island in the Gulf of Mannar is a major pilgrim center. Visit to Sri Ramanathaswamy Temple-situated near the sea on the eastern side, as massive sculptured pillars on either side and has the longest corridors in the world, Kurusadai Island-it is a Marine Biosphere, a paradise for the Marine Biologists and Nature lovers. Return to Madurai, and overnight

Day 11: Madurai / Kanyakumari

Morning breakfast, check and proceed to **Kanyakumari**- the land's end of India or the point where the three seas meet, enchanting Kanyakumari or Cape Comorin is one of the most popular tourist spots in the South India. On arrival check into hotel and evening visit to **Vivekananda Memorial**-built on the Vivekananda Rock where the

charismatic philosopher S w a m i Vivekananda meditated and transformed himself. Return to hotel and overnight.

Day 12: Kanyakumari / Kovalam

Morning breakfast, check and proceed to Kovalam. Kovalam-is an internationally renowned beach with three adjacent crescent beaches. It has been a favorite haunt of

tourists, on arrival transfer to a beach resort and rest of the day free. Return to hotel and overnight

Day 13: Kovalam

Morning breakfast and proceed for a full day sightseeing, visit to Vizhinjam Rock Cut Cave-the granite cave here encloses a one-celled shrine with a loose sculpture, Kuthiramalika (Puthenmalika) Palace Museum, Sree Chithra Art Gallery-the collection also includes paintings from China, Japan, Tibet and Bali. The Zoological Park -it is like a small jungle in the heart of the city.



Sacred Temples & Landscape of South India

Chennai / Mahabalipuram / Pondicherry / Tanjore Madurai / Thekkady / Kumarakom / Alleppey / Cochin 13 Nights / 14 Days



Day 01: Arrive at Chennai:

Meet on arrival at Chennai Airport and transfer to Hotel. Relax and overnight.

Day 02: Chennai - Kanchipuram - Mahabalipuram

Morning breakfast proceed for sightseeing of Chennai - visit the Fort St. George was declared a national monument in 1948 and most of its buildings have been converted into government offices, notably the Legislature and Secretariat. Visit the San Thome Cathedral, a Gothic-style Catholic church said to house the remains of St. Thomas, the 'Apostle of India', who died at nearby St Thomas Mount in 72 A.D. Afternoon drive to Mahabalipuram enroute visit Kanchipuram - known as the Golden City of a Thousand Temples, is one of the oldest towns in India. It is famous for both its temples, many of them remarkably well preserved and for its hand-woven silks. Kanchipuram is one of the seven sacred cities of India and it is the only one associated with both Shiva and Vishnu. Visit Ekambareshwar Temple, Kailashnath Temple, Kamakshi Temple, the Vaikunthaperumal Temple, all built in the 7th and 8th centuries. Later drive to Mahabalipuram. On arrival check into the hotel. Overnight.

Day 03: Mahabalipuram:

Morning breakfast and proceed for sightseeing tour of Mahabalipuram - is famous for its unique 7th-century Shore Temple, lovely beach and some of the most beautiful rock-cut temples in the world. Situated on the shore of the Bay of Bengal, Mahabalipuram was already a famous seaport in the 1st century AD. This town was a workshop for temple building. Visit the seven pagoda-style shore temples, lashed by the waves of the sea and the seven rathas or temple chariots, a group of monolithic





monuments & animal figures carved out of solid rock, the earliest known examples of Dravidian architecture. Afternoon at leisure for own activities. Overnight at the hotel.

Day 04: Mahabalipuram – Pondicherry Morning breakfast, checkout and drive to Pondicherry - This charming and wellrestored former French colony displays a Mediterranean aura, with its beautiful streets and whitewashed houses. On arrival check into Hotel. Later proceed to visit the famous Sri Aurobindo Ashram whose founder Sri Aurobindo emerged as a new type of thinker, one who combined in his vision - alacrity of the West with illumination of the East. Visit Auroville or the 'City of Dawn' -Designed by a French architect Roger Arger, it is a universal city-in-the-making whose purpose is human unity in the broadest sense of the word. Also visit the Eglise De Sacre Coeur De Jesus dedicated to the Sacred Heart of Jesus, this church is noted for its gothic architecture and stained glass panels which depict the entire life of Jesus Christ. Overnight.

Day 05: Pondicherry - Chidambaram - Taniore

Morning breakfast, checkout and drive to Tanjore enroute visit **Chidambaram** - has a beautiful temple dedicated to

Lord Shiva in the enthralling form of the Cosmic Dancer Nataraja. It is one of the few, which allows non-Hindus to visit the inner shrine. The peculiarity of the temple is its presiding deity - the Akasha Lingam or the ether lingam. The four tall entrance ways have carvings of the famous South Indian dance, Bharatanatyam. Later drive to Tanjore. On arrival check into Hotel. Overnight.

Day 06: Tanjore:

Morning breakfast and proceed to visit Tanjore – Once the capital of the Chola Empire from the 10th to the 14th centuries. A Chola king, Raja Chola, built the greatest of the empire's 74 temples, the Brahadeeswarar temple is an outstanding example of the Chola architecture. Guarding the inner shrine of the temple is the gigantic statue of Nandi, the Bull. The courtyard walls of the sanctum are covered with wall paintings from the Chola and Nayak periods, comparable to the famous Ajanta cave frescoes. Afternoon at leisure for own activities. Overnight at the hotel.

Day 07: Tanjore - Trichy - Madurai

Morning after breakfast checkout and drive to Trichy - visit the 'Rock Fort Temple' which rises abruptly to a height of 273 ft. A steep staircase cut into the rock leads to the Fort. At the first level

are the remnants of a huge hall blasted into ruins in 1772. The next storey is the Mathrubhuteshwarer Shrine dedicated to Shiva. Finally at the top of the hill, the 'Uchhi Pillayar Koil' - a Ganesh Temple offering a commanding view of the city. Later drive to Madurai. On arrival check into Hotel. Relax and overnight.

Day 08: Madurai:

Morning breakfast proceed to visit the Meenakshi temple one of the biggest temple complexes in India dedicated to Goddess Meenakshi. The high point of the Meenakshi temple is Hall of a "Thousand Pillars", built in the 16th Century which is as great a work of structural engineering as it is of art. Also visit the palace of Tirumala Nayak which is an example of the architectural mastery of the Nayaks - a blend of Hindu and Saracen architecture. Evening visit of the Meenakshi temple to attend the night ceremony at the temple at 9 pm. This is a ceremony that takes place every evening when the temple bronze of Lord Shiva is carried to the bedchamber of Parvati. The procession is accompanied by religious prayer and temple music. Overnight.

Day 09: Madurai – Thekkady

Morning breakfast checkout and drive to Thekkady. Sprawling across the Cardamom Hills of the Western Ghats, Thekkady is the home to one of the largest wildlife reserves in India. Alive with exotic flora and vibrant wildlife, it is the perfect getaway tucked away among hills. On arrival check into Hotel. Afternoon boat ride on the Lake of the famous Periyar wildlife sanctuary. An artificial lake or reservoir created by a dam on Periyar River is the heart of the Wildlife Sanctuary, where wild elephants, Asiatic Deer, Black Buck and even Tigers come to the banks of lake to drink water. Overnight.

Day 10: Thekkady – Kumarakom

Morning breakfast, checkout and drive to Kumarakom the winding "Ghats" lined with prosperous tea plantations & then arrive the fascinating countryside of low-lying palms and paddy fields to Kumarakom. Kumarakom-is a beautiful backwater village on the shores of the enchanting Vembanad Lake, crisscrossed with meandering

waterways and ancient cottages. Overnight.

Day 11: Kumarakom / Alleppey:



Day 03: Hospet – Hampi:



Built in the Dravidian style, the temple is dedicated to Banashankari, a form of Parvati. Return to hotel and overnight.




