

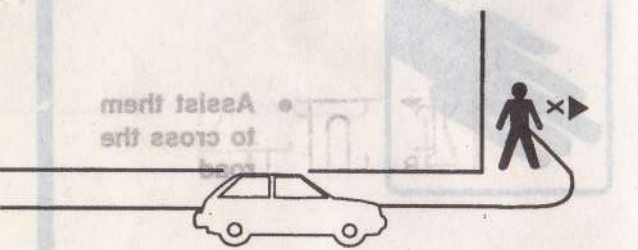
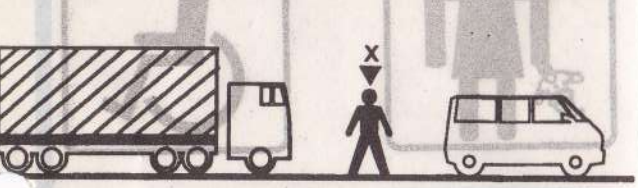
**Walk in a single file, if there is no foot-path.

at road bends.**

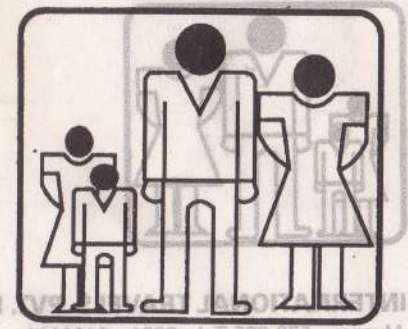
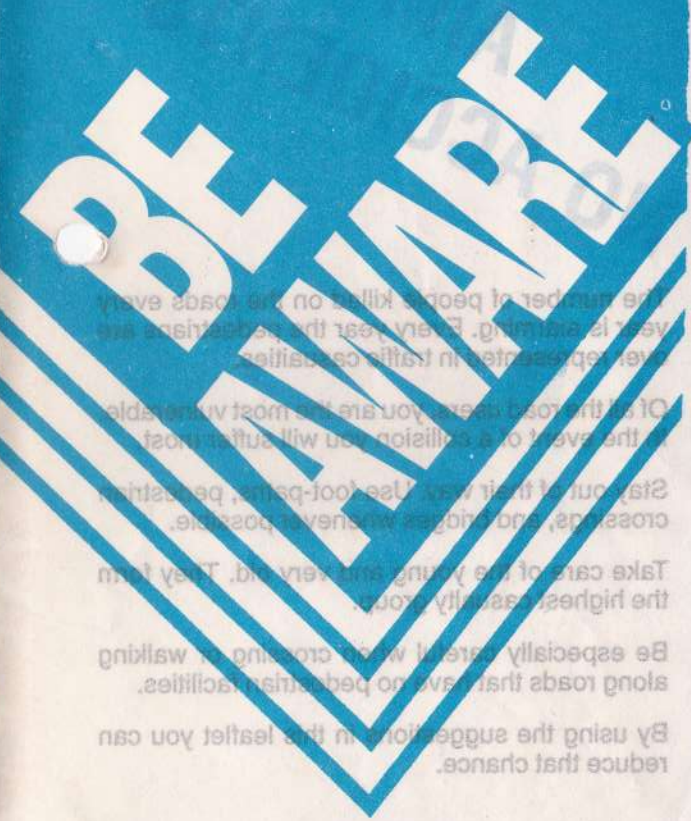

The number of people killed on the roads every year is alarming. Every year the pedestrians are over represented in traffic casualties.

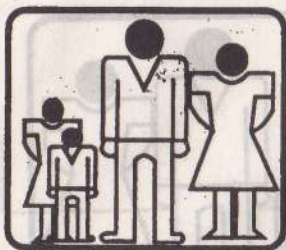
Of all the road users, you are the most vulnerable. In the event of a collision you will suffer most.

Stay out of their way. Use foot-paths, pedestrian crossings, and bridges whenever possible.

Take care of the young and very old. They form the highest casualty group.

Be especially careful when crossing or walking along roads that have no pedestrian facilities.

By using the suggestions in this leaflet you can reduce that chance.



BE AWARE OF YOUR SAFETY

You are the most vulnerable person on the road. Safety for you means staying out of the way of vehicles. Use the pedestrian facilities whenever they are around. Make a little effort to enjoy the rest of your life.

- Pedestrian lights
- Foot-paths
- Zebra crossings
- Overhead bridges
- Sub-ways



CROSSING THE ROAD

This is your most dangerous moment, 90% of the accidents involving pedestrians, occur when they are crossing the roads without using pedestrian crossing.

Pay careful attention to traffic and the speed of moving vehicles. Calmly judge the best time of move. Be patient and be careful.
